Fatigue wear was a main wear mechanism of corrugation. The wavelength of corrugated wear was approximately equal to the sliding speed multiplied by the period time of the friction-induced vibration. Friction Induced Vibration in Windscreen Wiper Contacts ... In addition to this, friction induced vibration is shown only to occur for glass surfaces with intermediate surface energies, which is possibly due to high contact angles preventing water reaching the contact.

Friction-induced vibration and dynamic friction laws ... Sliding friction can lead to unstable vibration. This vibration can be unwanted, e.g. brake noise, or wanted, e.g. in violin strings. Several excitation mechanisms of friction-induced vibration are known, but still not all excitations observed in practice can be explained. Friction-Induced Vibration, Chatter, Squeal, and Chaos ... The modeling of the friction force in mechanical systems depends on several factors. These include the material properties and geometry of the sliding surfaces, surface roughness, surface chemistry, sliding speed, temperature, and normal load. Conceptually, friction-induced vibration can be accomplished only when force-oscillations are accompanied by motion oscillations along the direction of the force oscillations with a suitable relative phase. That means, all type of brake noise originates as a self-excited oscillation which is the stick-slip phenomenon. Nonlinear Friction-Induced Vibration in Water-Lubricated ... The problem of friction-induced vibration and squeal in water-lubricated shipboard bearings has received extensive studies during the 1970s. These studies were dominated by experimental tests of section models that emulated the actual bearing dynamics.
